### Dear Parent,

We are well into the second half of our Autumn term and it is great to see our classrooms developing as their connected curriculum themes grow. I am delighted to welcome **Ophelia**, **Cody & Jamie** to our school – I know that everyone has given them a warm welcome and they have all fitted in brilliantly.

# **Covid Update**

Whilst we have fewer positive cases in school at present, I would like to thank you all for your support in ensuring that pupils who have symptoms are tested alongside family members and siblings. As we get into the winter season there may well be an upsurge in cases.

A quick reminder of the most recent advice from Public Health Cheshire which still stands:

We are now advising our primary schools to suggest to parents and carers that if one individual in a household tests positive, **ANY CHILDREN IN THAT HOUSEHOLD WHO ATTEND SHOULD**:

- Take a PCR test (ideally on Day 3-5 after first exposure), and
- Take a daily LFD test for 10 consecutive days from the date of first exposure
- Continue to attend school provided that their test results (PCR and LFD) are negative
- Self-isolate for 10 full days from the date of the test if any of their test results are positive
- In the event of a positive LFD test result, obtain a confirmatory PCR test
- If the confirmatory PCR test is taken within the two days following the positive LFD result and PCR result is negative, the young person can return to school.

It is important that you ensure that your child gets a test if they have any symptoms.


