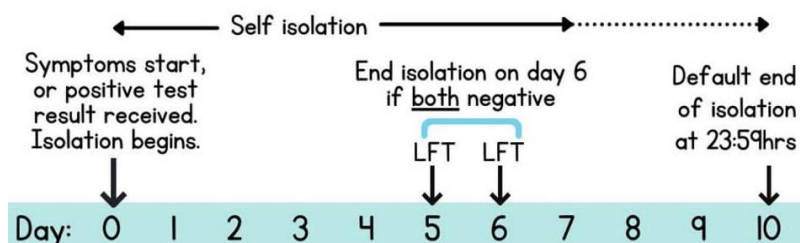
NEW GUIDANCE ON THE DURATION OF SELF-ISOLATION (17TH JAN, ENGLAND ONLY)



It is now possible to end self-isolation after 5 full days, following 2 negative LFTs taken 24 hours apart, and provided you do not have a temperature.

If you are still positive on your LFT, you must stay in isolation until you have had 2 consecutive negative tests taken on two consecutive days (or until the end of day 10).

This policy change may ease some of the pressures facing essential public services due to high worker absences.



Dear Parent,

I have contacted Cheshire Public Health today due to a rise in positive cases in some of our classes (Y3 and Nursery).

Please can I ask you to ensure that you keep your child at home if they have;

- a new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature and/or
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

Testing for students with symptoms can be arranged by calling 119 or via the NHS website: www.nhs.uk/coronavirus

It is also important that pupils over 5 have daily LFD tests if they are a close family contact.

Whilst we have had some staff absence, other members of staff have rallied around to ensure that all pupils who are able to can attend school as normally as possible.

I will continue to monitor the situation and will act on any further advice from Public Health should it be needed. At present, we are all doing as much as we can to mitigate transmission, including monitoring air quality using CO2 monitors – increasing ventilation when required. Additional cleaning in high case areas is undertaken and all staff continue to wear masks in communal areas.

Can I ask you all to continue to wear face masks (unless exempt) whilst on the school playground or coming into school.

Thanks you all for your continued support during very difficult times.
